

## GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISPLAY

### SPECIFICATIONS:

1. The size of the poster should not exceed 85 cm (w) x 150 cm (h)
2. Poster orientation must be portrait. Clear labels must be used for each section of the poster.
3. Text should be of sufficient size for easy reading at a distance of one (1) meter.
4. Title must be displayed clearly at the top of the poster and should include the names of the author(s) and the institution(s) of origin.
5. Names of Authors:
  - All co-investigators should be listed using full last name and first name.
  - Last name should be capitalized.
  - The principal investigator should be identified with an asterisk and the presenter's name underlined.
  - If you plan not to display your Abstract, please inform us as soon as possible.

### DISPLAY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Authors must prepare all posters beforehand in a form enabling easy mounting.
2. Please be advised that the display of Abstracts will be random by who comes first fix first basis, starting from one side, next, and then next, then next, until the end of one side, then continue to the other side. Please do not leave gaps between abstracts.
3. Author(s) are responsible for affixing and removing their poster during the conference.
  - Affixing Start Date: Wednesday, 11 March 2020 - After 21:00 **(the boards maybe available earlier, please check.)**
  - Removal Date: Saturday, 14 March 2020 - Before 13:00
4. Poster displayers are advised to be available to discuss their posters with the conference participants during coffee breaks.
5. Poster displayers are advised to be available for a tour by the Chairman and Members of the Scientific Committee. Please observe the daily congress's highlights for the times.
6. The organizers will not be liable for poster lost or damage.
